

COST & DETAILS *PARIS OF THE BELLE EPOQUE 2014*

PARIS OF THE BELLE EPOQUE, \$3499, land only; all travelers will be housed in single rooms (except couples opting to share a bed, in which case there is a 10% discount). Optional extension to include Day Trips around Paris: \$1750, minimum 4 people. Registration

Balance due April 1, 2014. Payment preferred by check; payment by Paypal incurs fees by the traveler. Registration minimum 8; maximum 16 participants. Registration after February 1, 2014 will incur the single supplement if we are unable to find a roommate for you.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations must be made in writing before March 1, 2014. Deposits are non-refundable after February 1, 2014, unless trip is cancelled by ***The French Traveler***. No refunds after March 1, 2014 under any circumstances. ***The French Traveler*** strongly recommends the purchase of trip cancellation insurance.

Eligibility

The ***Paris of the Belle Epoque 2014*** trip is open to Francophones and Francophiles alike, curious travelers interested in art, architecture, and Parisian culture; people with open minds and hearts, ready to imbibe a new culture in a charming city.

Participant responsibility

We will gladly discuss details of this trip with you. We expect that you read the pre-departure information and be in sufficient good health to undertake the trip. We use public transportation in Paris and walk at length, sometimes on bumpy cobblestone streets or on narrow sidewalks. We take metros and buses in cities and hire coach buses for our outside excursions. While this contributes to the charm of the experience, it requires the participant to be in good physical condition. Air conditioning in Europe is not as widespread as it is in the US, and hotel rooms are smaller. We focus on absorbing French

culture and expect our participants to do their best to adapt to France: *vive la différence!* If you have certain dietary or other restrictions, please ascertain beforehand that we are able to accommodate you. Vegetarian diets can usually be adapted, but we regret that our chefs cannot accommodate a vegan diet. Gluten-free diets are fairly easily accommodated in Paris.
